Limited Term Assistant Professor/ Senior Instructor

The Faculty of Law, University of Victoria, invites applications for a One-Year Limited Term position, subject to budgetary consideration. The successful applicant will be expected to teach courses and seminars in Constitutional Law or Family Law, and other areas, as well as participate in the delivery of the first year Legal Process program. The position also includes administrative responsibilities. The appointment, effective July 1, 2010, will be made at the rank of Assistant Professor or Senior Instructor.

To be hired as an Assistant Professor, the successful candidate must have completed an undergraduate degree in Law and hold an LL.M. or equivalent degree. Appointment at the rank of Senior Instructor requires successful completion of an undergraduate degree in Law, outstanding law school grades, and at least two years of practice or related experience. A record of successful teaching and publication in law and related fields would be an asset. Remuneration will be commensurate with educational background and experience.
